What a great Autumn-Get-Away! Thank you, Elaine and Sam and your Crew, for all the hard work you put in to putting on a great event! It was great to see so many painting friends that I had not seen in some time as well as to meet so many new Ladies who joined us from near and a far for the first time.

I wanted to share a couple of tips that I learned while there:

Judy Coats shared with us that she uses her micron pens that have dried out to make small dots. She just dips the pen tip in to the paint and then on to her surface when needing an extra small dot for something such as an eye.

Judy also shared that she uses the following:

Coral Cloud in place of Medium Flesh/Flesh tone; Watermelon Slice instead of Hot Shot Red and Irish Moss instead of Hot Shot Green.

Karen Ortman shared with my class that she uses decoupage and scrapbook paper to finish the back of her paintings on wood boards, it leaves a very nice finish.
