NOTE: 2 free fair tickets per exhibitor regardless of how many items you enter. A free fair ticket will be provided for each volunteer for the Make & Take It also.

- 1. If you would like to submit an item or several for the HomeMade Exhibit,
 - a. Go to the Fair website: sdfair.com
 - b. Select Participate in the yellow header
 - c. Scroll down to <u>Decorative Arts</u> (or other artwork you would like to enter)
 - d. Click pink button: <u>Enter Now</u> for digital entry or <u>Download Entry Materials</u> (if you prefer paper).
 - e. Select <u>New Exhibitor</u> unless you have already registered THIS year.
 - a. Choose Department: <u>HomeMade;</u> scroll down to find <u>Division</u>. I chose <u>118</u> <u>Adult: Tole & Decorative Painting</u>
 - f. Then select <u>Class</u>: I chose <u>Wood</u>, since I am submitting a wooden note box.
 - g. When completed, please print the Receipt and keep it in case Andrea and I need to take it with your entry on <u>Saturday, May 18</u>. We will pick up your entry at the Paint-In on Saturday between 1:30 – 2:00 PM or prior to May 18 from you, and deliver all entries to the Fair by 4:00 PM on May 18.
 - h. <u>PLEASE let Sheri Barker or Andrea Toth know if you are submitting something for the Fair</u> so we can arrange to pick it up from you on or before May 18 AND so that we can notify the HomeMade team that we are bringing a group of entries, as they requested.
- 2. If you would like to help with the Make & Take It on Saturday, June 22:
 - a. Please let Sheri Barker or Andrea Toth know if you would like to volunteer to help with the Make & Take It. We need at least 4 volunteers to make this activity possible.
 - b. Please plan to carpool with the Brush Whacker team (Sheri Barker's 7-passenger car) or with other friends/family. Parking passes for volunteers will be provided to the Horse Park, but need to be requested in advance. We will request a Green Lot pass for anyone who carpools with Sheri Barker because we have so much to transport for the Make & Take It.
 - c. If you would like to donate paint or brushes, please let Sheri or Andrea know so we can arrange to get them up from you. Our current supply was donated in 2019.

Everyone is encouraged to enter a fair themed item. The HomeMade exhibit will focus on Retro Fashion.



This event is always full of fantastic classes, food, fun, friendship, a great raffle, and lots of laughter!

We would like to invite you to submit projects to teach at the Getaway. This is an *in-person* event. Classes will be held Wednesday through Friday and are for all levels of painters. Submissions using various painting mediums (acrylics, watercolors, pencils, mixed media, etc.) are welcome.

Here are the details:

- Submissions are due by April 5, 2024
- To submit: Email a high-resolution image (jpeg format) and project description information sheet (see next page) for each submission to jdbeldg@yahoo.com with <u>AGA Teacher Submission</u> in the subject line of the email. We recommend your project photo be taken with proper lighting, contrasting background and full-frame (as close-up as possible with minimal background showing). Up to 3 photos per project may be submitted to show all project sides.
- If you are unable to submit your project by email, please mail a 4" x 6" quality photo and project description information sheet (see next page) to:

- **Project selection**: Projects are voted on by the Brush Whacker members and the projects that receive the most votes are offered at the Getaway.
- **Project fee**: For all classes that are selected, teachers are required to provide students with prepped surfaces, patterns, instructions, photos, class paint and any materials needed to complete the project (i.e., glue, Decoupage, screws, hanging wire, material for bows, etc.). Teachers should include the cost of these items in their project fee. Project fees are paid directly to teachers by their students at the Getaway.
- **Specialty items**: Teachers should list any specialty items students need to bring to class on the project description information sheet. Teachers may sell specialty items (stencils, stamps, brushes, etc.) to their students at the Getaway. Teachers will be provided with the email addresses of their students so they may contact the students and take pre-orders of specialty items prior to the get-away if they wish.
- **Class size**: Maximum number of students per class is 15. If you have a minimum of 8 students enrolled in your class at the registration deadline, you are under contract to teach that class. If there are less than 8 students enrolled, it will be your choice whether to teach the class or not.
- **Class fee**: Teachers will receive \$20.00 per student for a 4-hour class. Teachers receive class fees for all registered students including any "no shows".
- **Classroom**: Teachers will need to bring any equipment they wish to use to teach (i.e., camera, projector, screen, extension cords, power strips, etc.). Tables will be provided by the resort. All classes will be held in a large ballroom. Students will be seated two to a table. A staging area will be available to store your class materials. Please label your boxes clearly.
- **Registration**: We would love for our teachers to participate in the entire event, including classes, lodging, and meals. The painting room fees are covered by meeting our hotel and food guarantees.
- Please email me with any questions about individual meal or room costs.
- A mileage reimbursement is **not** provided.
- Teachers may submit projects for up to 20 hours of class time... in 4-hour blocks.

Submissions are voted on by the San Diego Brush Whacker membership using your photo and description alone. Please be detailed about size, surface, medium and cost, along with a high-resolution image or quality photograph for each submission. **Voting will take place online from April 15 – 23, 2024**. You will be notified of the results by April 25, 2024.

I hope you will consider sharing your talent with us! This event averages 65 painters which includes our members, along with painters from other clubs. Feel free to email Elaine with any questions or concerns. We are looking forward to hearing from you!
